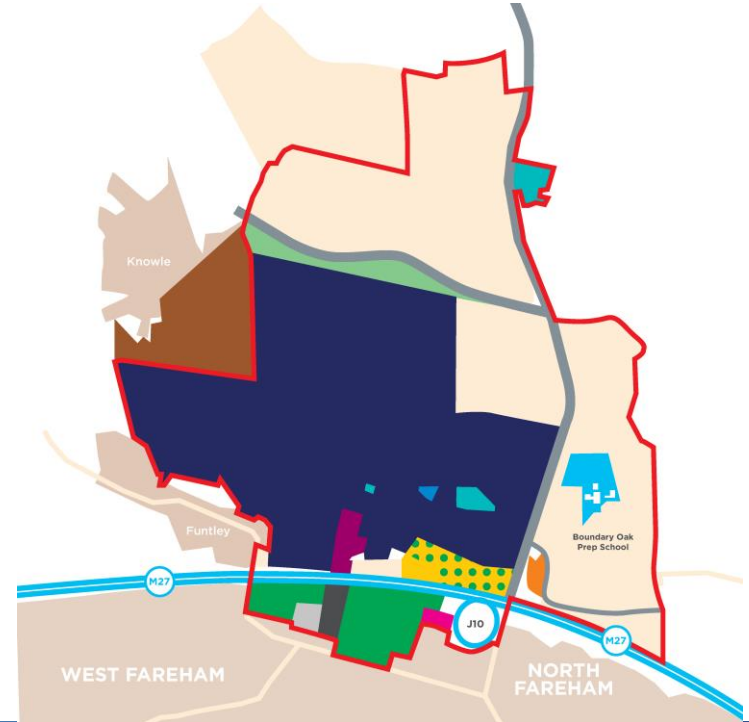
What's Happening Now?
