

Prior to visiting the slipway:

1. Display a hull and data tag registration number on your craft.
2. Ensure you have third party insurance.
3. Ensure your craft is well maintained.
4. Check local tide and weather conditions
5. Familiarise yourself with the contents of QHM's General Direction 1/16 Personal Watercraft, Water Skiing, Board Sailing and Swimming at: www.royalnavy.mod.uk/qhm/portsmouth/leisure/personal-watercraft
6. If you are operating a Personal Watercraft (Jet Ski), apply for and obtain a free license by filling in the application at: www.royalnavy.mod.uk/qhm/portsmouth/leisure/personal-watercraft/pwc-license

On arrival at the slipway:

1. Park your vehicle and trailer considerably.
2. Read and follow the instructions on the signs provided

Launching and Operating Your Craft:

- Navigate your craft safely.
- Keep clear of other water users.
- Do not exceed 10 knots on a PWC unless in the designated area or more than 1000 yards from shore.
- Keep engine noise to a minimum.
- For your own safety you are advised to wear a suitable buoyancy aid and helmet.
- No persons under the age of 12 years should use personal water craft.
- Do not play 'cat and mouse' - collisions are common.
- Do not water ski without a driver and observer on board.
- Do not water ski within 1000 yards of the shore.
- Do not drink alcohol prior to operating your craft.

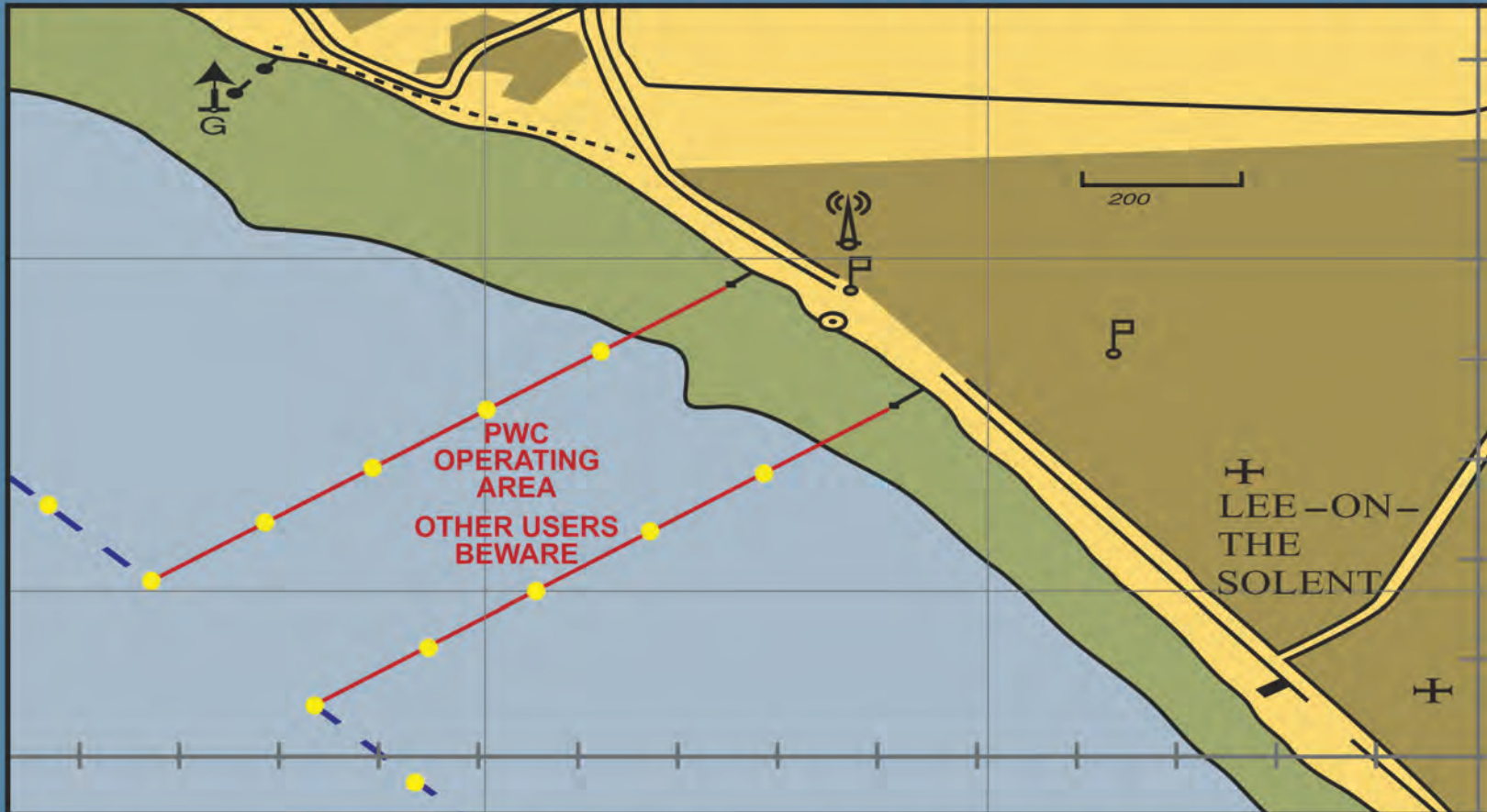
