8 Birdwood Grove, Portchester, PO16 8AF

A plant collector's dream with an amazing array of plants from far reaching corners of the world offering an adventure in this subtropical themed oasis. Dramatic displays of sumptuous foliage and floral delights await with the creative use of artistic structures intended to emulate a tropical jungle.

51 Longmynd Drive, Fareham, PO14 1SH

An artistic garden incorporating an extensive collection of plants presented with an eye for detail with fine lawns, succulents and summer delights set off by feature containers and unusual artwork arranged over a number of levels. There are numerous seating areas to take in the delights.

10 Peak Drive, Fareham, PO14 1RL

Sweeping herbaceous borders, heady fragrance and sense of peace set the scene for this period style garden which is designed to be totally organic and wildlife friendly with the importance of organic gardening seen at every turn. There are also fruit and vegetable gardens along with a woodland walk leading to a unique and enchanting vintage Wendy House with its natural pond.

213 Highlands Road, Fareham, PO15 5BQ

This small but perfectly designed urban garden includes a patio, dual level decking, a water feature and covered pergola set amongst a collection of palms, ferns, shrubs and small trees with seasonal and perennial delights showcasing what can be done with such a small space.

112 Kiln Road, Fareham, PO16 7UN

Arranged over a number of terraces and linked by steps and lawns this vast garden is a feast of colourful beds, borders and rockeries, with interest at every level. There is a Japanese themed area, gravel garden and summer house all nestled in a green space that is both golfer and child friendly with its very own mini golf experience.

1 The Cloisters, Fareham, POI5 5PU

On arrival you enter a cottage style front garden which is complemented to the rear with a host of bright seasonal and perennial delights set around the water features. There is also a productive working garden with a range of soft fruits and vegetables.

66 Catisfield Road, Titchfield, PO15 5LU

A garden that has been lovingly nurtured over a 30 year period with a palette of perennial and permanent shrubs arranged to best effect and set aside two ponds and a productive vegetable patch.

20 Titchfield Park Road, Titchfield, PO15 5RW

This delightful organic garden is all about the owners love of nature and wildlife with every angle of its design and growing intended to support the environment around us whilst having a wide range of plants that are ornamental and colourful. This is set aside lawns, orchard fruit and productive vegetable patch.
