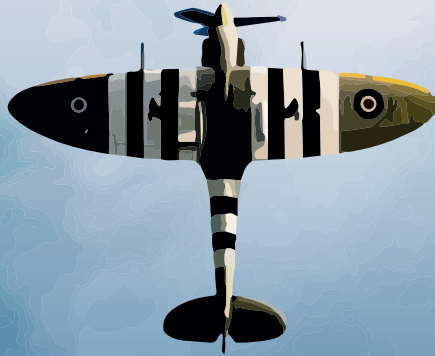

Fareham Borough Council is hosting D-Day 75 at Daedalus, a community event for 10,000 residents over the weekend of 8/9 June 2019. Opening hours for the public are 10:00am – 5:00pm on Saturday and 10:00am – 4:00pm on Sunday.

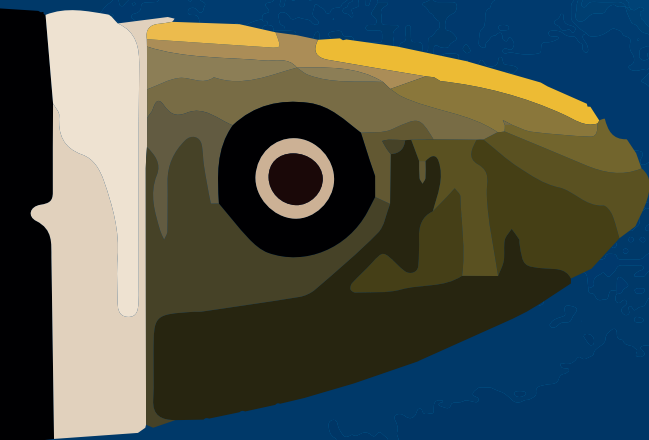
Daedalus was the busiest airfield in the UK on D-Day and is synonymous with Spitfires and Seafires. The event will play tribute to the site's historic significance and will incorporate flyovers, parachute drops, static aircraft, a funfair, children's activities and community and shopping marquees as part of the festivities.

D-Day 75 will be heavily promoted on our website, social media channels, radio campaigns, press and promotion around the Borough.

Your stall would be located under a marquee with other stall holders. Vehicles can unload by the marquee to set up and pack away. Timings for this will be

arranged nearer the time. A space will be allocated to you on arrival which allows for a 2m x 1m table. You will need to bring your own table and cloth, seating plus any other items you require for the duration of the event. There will be overnight security on the Saturday.

There is no pitch fee for 'not for profit' organisations, and the pitch fee for commercial stall holders is £40 for the event weekend. If you are interested and would like to book a pitch, please let me have details outlining what you will offer at the event. We may be able to offer more than one pitch per booking but this will be subject to availability.
