Community Infrastructure Levy - Statement of the Representations Procedure

Under Regulation 16 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended) Fareham Borough Council is inviting representations on the Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Charging Schedule from 19 June - 31 July 2020. Following this consultation period, Fareham Borough Council intends to submit, under Section 212 of Planning Act 2008 the Draft Charging Schedule for Examination.

In accordance with the regulations, the Council has made available for inspection:

- The Draft Charging Schedule
- Relevant evidence supporting the Draft Charging Schedule

The Draft Charging Schedule and supporting evidence can be viewed on the Council's website at: www.fareham.gov.uk/CIL or by appointment at the civic offices by calling the Planning Strategy team on 01329 824601.

Right to Be Heard

Any person who makes representations about the Draft Charging Schedule in accordance with the Statement of the Representations Procedure may request the 'right to be heard' at the examination. This request must be submitted in writing before the end of this consultation on 31 July 2020. Representations may also be accompanied by a request to be notified, at a specified address, of any of the following:

- That the Draft Charging Schedule has been submitted to the examiner in accordance with section 212 of Planning Act 2008;
- The publication of the recommendations of the examiner and the reasons for those recommendations;
- The approval of the Charging Schedule by the Council.

How to Make Representations



Representations on the Draft Charging Schedule must be made by 11:59pm on the 31st July 2020 and submitted through any of the following methods. All representations received will be shared with the appointed Inspector for the examination process. Any person who has made representations about the Draft Charging Schedule may withdraw those representations at any time by giving notice in writing to the Council either by e-mail or by post at the addresses given above.
