## **WITHDRAWAL STATEMENT**

### **WARSASH NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT FORUM AND AREA**

Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

#### **The purpose of this document**

This document provides a record of the written notification to withdraw the designation of the Warsash Neighbourhood Forum and Neighbourhood Area for the purposes of creating a neighbourhood plan.

#### **Relevant Regulations and National Planning Policy Guidance**

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) states that where a neighbourhood forum gives notice to a Local Planning Authority (LPA) that it no longer wishes to be designated as the neighbourhood forum for a neighbourhood area, the LPA must withdraw the designation of the neighbourhood forum.

As soon as possible after withdrawing the designation of the neighbourhood forum the LPA must publicise on their website:

- A statement setting out the details of the withdrawal (“the withdrawal statement”)
- Details of when and where the withdrawal statement may be inspected.

#### **Outcomes**

The acting Chairman of the Warsash Neighbourhood Forum gave formal notice to the Council on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020 that the forum had been disbanded. The Chairman requested that the Council initiate the formal procedures necessary to withdraw the Forum’s designation in relation to Neighbourhood Planning.

In accordance with Regulation 12 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), this statement confirms the withdrawal of the Warsash Neighbourhood Development Forum and the Neighbourhood Area for purposes of producing a neighbourhood plan.
