#### 1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 The Fareham Borough Council Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Schedule was approved by Full Council on the 25th April 2013 and came into effect on the 1st May 2013. Planning developments permitted from 1st of May will potentially be liable to pay the Levy as per the schedule of charges.
- 1.2 Regulation 123 of the Community Infrastructure Regulations 2010 (as amended) restricts the use of planning obligations for infrastructure that will be funded in whole or in part by the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). This is to ensure there is no duplication between CIL and planning obligations secured through s106 agreements in funding the same infrastructure projects.
- 1.3 Regulation 62 of the CIL Regulations (as amended) requires a Charging Authority to:

Prepare a report for any financial year ("the reported year") in which:-

- a) it collects CIL, or CIL is collected on its behalf; or
- b) an amount of CIL collected by it or another person on its behalf (whether in the reported year or any other) has not been spent."
- 1.4 The financial year to which this document relates is 2017/18.

## 2.0 Monitoring

2.1 Table 1 below sets out the CIL Monitoring information as required by Regulation 62 (4).
