**10. CCTV**

On 14 January 2004 the Leisure and Community Review Panel considered a report on CCTV provision in the Borough of Fareham. The Panel subsequently recommended to the Executive that they request the Vandalism Task Force to examine the effectiveness of the Council's CCTV system.

Such a review will require the involvement of the Police, the company operating the CCTV control centre and Gosport Borough Council (our partners in the provision of a joint CCTV system). It is therefore considered more appropriate for the review to be co-ordinated by the Community Safety Partnership, with the results made available to a later meeting of the Vandalism Task Force. The Task Force is requested to confirm this approach”.
