



### Expert advice


- Council has:
  - Instructed Landscape Consultants
  - Instructed a surveyor to look at business/ EZ Impacts
- We are appointing a specialist to review the impacts upon the operational airfield
- Public Health England "not likely to lead to significant public health impacts"
- Environment Agency No objection



#### Next steps...

#### Application remains under consideration:

- Receive outstanding consultation advice
- Appraise information and seek clarification/changes from the applicant if needed
- Prepare a recommendation to the Planning Committee
- Autumn 2016



### Call In by Government?

- Council has contacted the National Planning Casework Unit (NPCU)
- No intervention from NPCU at this stage
- NPCU to review committee report and recommendation
- Will make a decision on "call in" at that time.
