

Fareham Borough Local Plan Part 2: Development Sites and Policies

Adoption Statement

Adoption

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Fareham Borough Council adopted the Local Plan Part 2: Development Sites and Policies on 8 June 2015.

Inspector David Hogger BA MSc MRTPI MCIHT, an independent inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, undertook examination of the Development Sites and Policies Plan which included a public hearing session held over two weeks in November 2014. The Inspector's Report for the Development Sites and Policies Plan was received on 12 May 2015 and concluded that the Plan is sound and legally compliant, subject to the Inspector's main modifications pursuant to Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The adopted version of the Development Sites and Policies Plan incorporates all of the main modifications set out in Appendix 1 of the Inspector's Report.

Subject Matter

The Development Sites and Policies (DSP) Plan (June 2015) forms Part 2 of the statutory Local Plan for the Borough and follows-on from Part 1: Core Strategy, which was adopted in August 2011. The DSP Plan replaces the remaining saved policies from the Fareham Borough Local Plan Review (June 2000).

The main aim of the DSP plan is to allocate land to help deliver the development requirements for housing and employment set out in the Core Strategy. The DSP Plan also includes Development Management policies to supplement those in the Core Strategy.

Challenge

Any person aggrieved by the Fareham Borough Development Sites and Policies Plan (June 2015) may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the plan is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than 23:59 on 20 July 2015 (six weeks after the date of adoption specified above).
