I support the keeping of the car parking spaces in Portchester District Centre car parks, but for shoppers only. Not commuters. Many people park their cars for the day in the free south car park and take up parking space for shoppers One evening at 5:30pm, with most shops closed, I counted over 40 cars still parked By restricting all day parking and using the lorry park for cars, there would be room for a large supermarket, yet still maintaining more than adequate parking space for shoppers cars. LIDL said to site a store there would lose 76 parking spaces. not counting the lorry park, there are still an additional 170 spaces that could be used for shoppers DMM20 - should differentiate between shopper (retail) parking spaces - keeping numbers, and all day commuters parking which should be time limited FBC should carry out a survey in the south car park to see how many shoppers (retail) parking spaces are really needed.
