

Fareham Local Plan: Notification of Examination & Start of Hearing Sessions Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 Regulation 24

The Council submitted the Fareham Local Plan to the Secretary of State for public examination on 30th September 2021. As part of the examination process public hearings are being held to assess the legal compliance, "soundness" of the plan and whether it is consistent with national policy.

The hearings will commence on Tuesday 8th March 2022 at 10:00AM and more than likely will take place virtually. They are expected to run until early April and a draft programme is available on our website https://www.fareham.gov.uk/planning/local_plan/examination/news.aspx.

The Secretary of State has appointed Helen Hockenhull BA(Hons) B.PI MRTPI to undertake the examination.
