

#### Introduction

- Welborne Plan is 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 documents in Fareham Local Plan
- Covers plan period to 2036
- Sets out planning framework for the delivery of Welborne
- Proposals for homes, employment, retail, community infrastructure, transport and significant green space
- It will be a material consideration in determining planning applications

#### Publication Welborne Plan Consultation

Council approved 13 February 2014

Publication Plan published for representations 28 February to 11 April

635 responses addressing "soundness"

Publication Plan and minor amendments as per Council resolution submitted to Inspectorate

Welborne Plan and Development Sites and Policies Plan submitted to Planning Inspectorate

Likely timetable for Examination

#### Suggested Change – School Location


Suggested change to Welborne Plan policy WEL16:



# Design Guidance - Objectives


- High quality, sustainable design that meets the vision for Welborne.

# Design Guidance - Purpose

- The Council's expectations for design quality – what we mean by "good design"
- Sets out the principles behind the Strategic Framework Diagram
- What needs to be included in planning applications – the role of the Structuring Plan, Comprehensive Masterplan and Strategic Design Codes.
- Used to assess planning applications



- It outlines the methodology for securing developer funding for infrastructure and affordable housing through the use of planning agreements
- Identifies affordable housing needs requirements and how they may be met
- Provides essential background evidence for the review of the Community Infrastructure Levy
- For use by site developers, the Council and infrastructure providers

Welborne Plan recognises different options for detailed design


One option was included in the Welborne Plan for purposes of illustrating how Welborne may be delivered

Detailed design will come through the Transport Assessment process to accompany developer planning application




