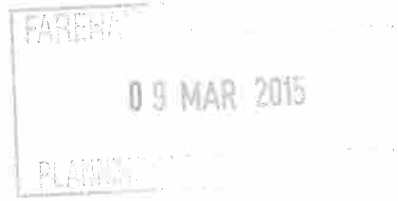

Re the proposed Modifications to the Fareham Borough Local Plan Part 3: The Welborne Plan - Surely the very fact this plan needs such major modifications should render the whole unsound & be a means for rejection.
