The precise width of settlement buffers is a matter for detailed design and any increase in buffer distance would be more accurately informed as a result of the assessment of the proposed development through the planning application process and the identification of appropriate mitigation measures to overcome any significant adverse impact. In any event a maximum width of settlement buffer of 50 metres is adequate in all circumstances. The introduction of the minimum building to building distance is unnecessary, overly onerous and unhelpful to the future detailed design of Welborne.
